

Guerrilla Girls in Rauschenberg Gallery

Florida SouthWestern State College's Bob Rauschenberg Gallery presents 'Guerrilla Girls: Rattling Cages Since 1985,' a site-specific exhibition and newly-commissioned interactive installation from January 17-March 23.

An internationally-renowned feminist advocacy and art collective, the Guerrilla Girls maintain anonymity while confronting and addressing systemic problems of gender and racial parity in the art world. They have designed a participatory chalkboard installation for visitor 'complaints' and covered the Bob Rauschenberg Gallery floor-to-ceiling with an immersive selection of the group's most notable public art/protest poster campaigns.

There is an opening reception January 17, 7-8:30pm, following a lecture by FSW Humanities professor, Dr. Wendy Chase at 6pm. Both events are free.
